

STRIKER SOCCER CHALLENGE MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Your web site is www.strikersundays.com. Does this imply that your games are only played on Sundays?

A: No! Games are played primarily on Saturday and Sundays. Additionally, there might be some Friday evening games and games on a Monday (Usually when your players are off from school.

Q: Does my team play at a set time and a set day throughout the winter? As an example, does my team play on Saturday's between 11AM and 2PM?

A: No. In an effort to avoid conflicts amongst the 100+ teams that will play in the Striker Soccer Challenge, we alternate game dates and times. Many younger teams have religious commitments in the mornings, and many teams have multiple sport conflicts. By staggering game times we avoid 99% of the conflicts with other player commitments.

Q: How many games are played in the Striker Soccer Challenge, and does my team play on consecutive or every other weekend?

A: Your team will play 8 games over the winter months, spread out over 16 weekends. Your team will play at various start times throughout the day, and your schedule will be built around a schedule that brings you the most competitive and parity based platform. Thus, there might be instances where your team will play two weekends in a row, and then be off for a week, or vice versa.

Q: Do I have to pay for the Referees before each game, and how good are they?

A: You DO NOT have to pay for the referees before each game. The cost of the referees is already included in the cost to join. The referees are all certified and very experienced. The referees all report to a Head Referee before and after every game. The referees ref either high school or college soccer games and cannot be confused for middle school or high school players.

Q: Are games played with offsides, corner kicks, and throw-ins?

A: Yes all games are played with offsides, corner kicks, and throw-ins.

Q: I coach both a U9 and U10 teams and want to know if we are playing on a half field and off inflatable walls?

A: All ages play on a full field. There are no inflatable walls to play off of, or climb over to retrieve the ball.

Q: What are the dimensions of the field and how many players can play in my age group?

A: The field is approximately 72 yards long and 36 yards wide. Each age group has minimum and maximum players allowed to play at the same time per team. Please refer to the “Rules” for your appropriate age.

Q: How many players can I have on my roster?

A: U9 & U10, 15 players, U11 thru U14, 18 players, U15 thru HS, 21 players.

Q: Can I have “Guest Players”?

A: Yes, each team is allowed three guest players over the winter. All guest player requests must be submitted no later than 6 PM Wednesday prior to your upcoming game.

Q: How many minutes long are the games?

A: 50 minutes long and a 5 minute break at the half.

Q: I coach a division 6 team. Will I be playing division 1 teams in my age group?

A: Absolutely not. The scheduling committee works very hard creating the best possible parity schedule for all teams.

Q: What is the cost to play in the Striker Soccer Challenge?

A: Early registration cost is \$1,695, late registration is \$1,795.

Q: Do I have to pay the full amount at time of registration?

A: No. You can pay either 25% or 100% at time of registration.

Q: Can I get a refund if I don't like the competition.

A: If the Striker Soccer Challenge does not offer you a competitive bracket to play in, then yes, ownership will return 100% of any monies you have paid.
